As of June 23rd social distancing restrictions of 2m would allow for 5 or 6 people spaced along the operating bank. In practice the pontoon would allow 2 at a time. Buoyancy aids, oars and rowlocks are in the club store.

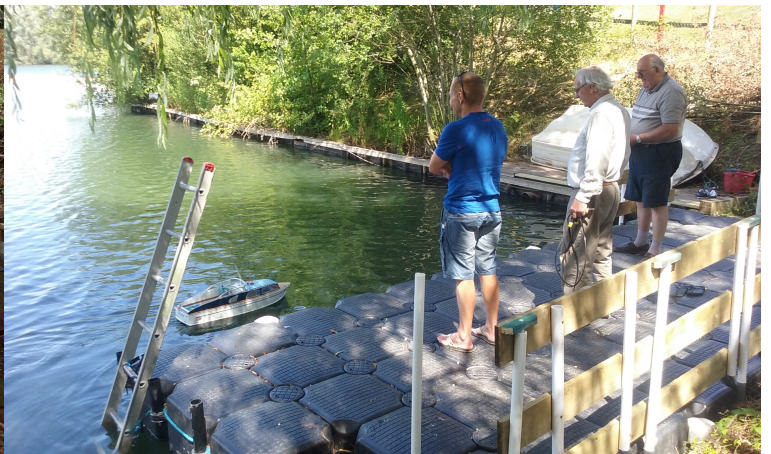
MTMBC Timeslots

If people are in, or on, the water ***Fast Electric boats must not be run.***

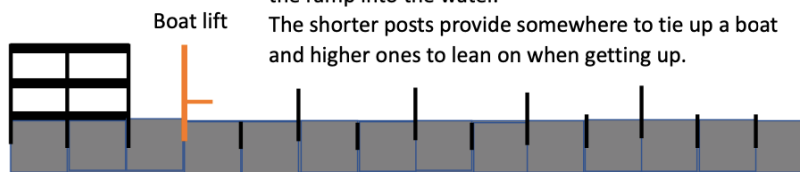


Pontoon Access

View from standing on the pontoon looking at the shore
Hand rails along the rear edge except where the ramp comes onto the pontoon.



Hand rail to prevent members with trolleys running from the ramp into the water.
The shorter posts provide somewhere to tie up a boat and higher ones to lean on when getting up.
